1. Executive Summary

The Shenhua Watermark CCC continued to operate within the Department of Planning, Industry & Environment Community Consultative Committee Guidelines during the year. All CCC members have maintained their code of conduct agreement and declarations of pecuniary and non-pecuniary interests.

Two CCC meetings were held during the year. The CCC adopted a procedure of draft minutes being circulated for comment within 7 days of the meeting and the final minutes being circulated and uploaded to the Company website to permit CCC members to use them for their stakeholder consultation activities.

Most activity during 2020 involved preparation on Environmental Management Plans (EMPs) for approval by either the State or Federal agencies. The following EMPs were approved; Environmental Management Strategy; Noise Management Plan; Traffic Management Plan; Blast Management Plan; Air Quality Management Plan; Heritage Management Plan; and the Biodiversity Management Plan.

Late June 2020 an application for the granting of a Mining Lease (ML) was submitted to the Department of Regional NSW.

2. CCC activities over last 12 months

- Two (2) meetings held during 2020.
- All meetings were reasonably well attended
- CCC members continued to raise land management issues to which the company provided a detailed response.
- Gunnedah and Liverpool Plains Shire Councils changed their representatives to the CCC.

- Outstanding application for a Mining Lease (ML).
- Outstanding EMPs include: Water Management Plan; and Koala Plan of Management.


4. Focus for next 12 months
