The Clarence Colliery CCC has been kept well informed of the activities undertaken at the mine and upcoming projects the mine will be undertaking at the quarterly meetings. 2. CCC activities over last 12 months

During 2018 CCC Meeting were held on the following dates:

The meetings have been attended by nominated community members, Clarence Colliery and Lithgow City Council.

One Site inspection was undertaken of the Clarence Colliery Pit Top.

Each meeting follows a thorough reporting format that ensures the information provided by Clarence Colliery is comprehensive and aims to effectively engage all members of the CCC. Topics covered include:

- A summary of any planned changes to consents, licenses and other approvals.
- Operational summary of tonnes mined.
- Environmental performance which includes reporting on air quality, noise, water and subsidence results (against consent criteria).
- Environmental management reporting includes flora and fauna, cultural heritage rehabilitation and general land management.
- Clarence also reports on community engagement activities and complaints.

Key areas of interest to the CCC included the 700S Drilling Program, the transfer of water from the Wollangambe River and the rehabilitation process for REA III. The CCC have been kept informed of progress and regulatory meetings in regards to the Cox's River Pipeline.

3. Key issues

The Clarence CCC operates effectively with no significant issues outstanding. Key focus areas have been discussed in Section 2.
